1. Be it further enacted. If at the La Payette Artillery, shall be de-tached from the regiment of a tillery to which it how belongs, and be at-tached to be first regiment of North Carolina volunteers

111 Be it further enacted, That no memb r of the La Fayette Artillery; share by sempt of on the performance of military duty in said company, by earoning times this any fire or other company whatever.

IV. Be it jurther enacted, 'That this act shall be in force from and after the rath accounterest, and all laws and clauses of laws coming within the meaning and surview of this act, be, and the same are hereby repealed.

#### CHAPTER LXXXVI.

An act to incorporate the Macon county Agricultural Society. Be it enauted by the General Assembly of the State of North Caroling, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same. That Jesse R. Siler, Luke Barnard, John Dobson and John Hall of the county of Macon and their associates, be, and they are hereby constituted & body politic and corporate, to be known in law, by the name and style of the Macon County Agricultural Society, for the purpose of encouraging agriculture and family domestic mainfacture in the said county.

11. Be it further enacted, That there shall be a president, treasurer and secretary, appointed by the Society, who together with five directors shall constitute a based for the transaction of business. III. Be it further enacted. That the board of managers and their succes-

sors in office, shill be able and capable in law to sue and be sued, plead and be impleaded, to pass all such bye laws, rules and regulations for the goveroment of the society, as a majority of them may think proper, not inconsistent with the constitution and laws of the State:

#### CHAPTER LXXXVII.

An act to amend an act, passed in the year one thoosand eight hundred and twenty nine, entitled an act to authorise the forming a Fire Engine Company in the town of Efizabeth City.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of North Carolina, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That the number of memory limited by the aforesaid act, to the aforesaid Fire Engine Company, b increased to forty.

Be it further enacted, That such additional members enrolled, pursu -H ant to the provisions of this act, be, and they are hereby made subject to the rules, penalties and exemptions beretofore established by law for the government of said company.
