CHAPTER LXXXVI.

AN ACT TO AMEND AN ACT ENTITLED AN ACT TO INCORPORATE THE M'LEAN HOOK AND LADDER COMPANY, NUMBER ONE, OF THE TOWN OF FAYETTEVILLE.

SECTION 1. *The General Assembly of North Carolina do enact*, That the officers and members of the McLean Hook and Ladder Company, number one, in the town of Fayetteville, chartered the twenty-eighth day of March, anno domini one thousand eight hundred and seventy, be and hereby are exempt from the payment of any poll tax to said town. Amendment.

SEC. 2. That the chief fire warden of the town of Fayetteville shall be exempt from duty in the militia, from serving on juries and from poll tax to town. Exemptions.

SEC. 3. This act shall be in force from and after its ratification. When to be in force.
