IV. AND be it further Enacted, by the Authority aforefaid, That each respective Subscriber who shall subscribe for any Lot or Lots in the faid Town, shall within one Month after it shall be afcertained to whom each of the faid Lots doth belong, in Manner herein before mentioned, pay and fatisfy to the faid Directors, or one of them, the Sum of Fifty Shillings for each Lot by him fubfcribed for; and in Cafe of the Neglect or Refutal of any Subscriber to pay the faid Sum, the faid Directors shall and may commence and profecute a Suit for the fame, and therein shall recover Judgment, with Cofts of Suit. And the faid Directors shall, as foon as they receive the faid Money, pay and fatisfy to the faid John Smith, his Heirs or Afligns, the Sum of Forty Shillings for each Lot, in full Satisfaction for the faid Land; and the other Ten Shillings shall be applied towards defraying the Expences of laying off and improving the faid Town, as a Majority of the Directors shall think proper.

V. A N D for continuing the Succession of the Directors until the faid Town shall be incorporated; Be it further Enacted, by the Authority aforefaid, That in Cafe of the Death, Refufal to act, or Removal out of the County, of any of the faid Directors, the furviving Directors, or a Majority of them, shall assemble, and are hereby impowered, from Time to Time, by Inftrument of Writing, under their respective Hands and Seals, to nominate fome other Perfon, being a Freeholder of the faid Town, in the Place of him fo dying, refuling to act, or removing out of the County ; which new Director fo nominated and appointed, shall from thenceforth have the like Power and Authority in all Things in the Matters herein contained, as if he had been expressly named and appointed in and by this Act.

Referve of . ots to the VI. PROVIDED nevertheles, That the faid John Smith shall have to his own Use a Referve of Seven Lots, exclusive of the faid One Hundred Acres, to fecure his Dwelling House and other Houses belonging to him now on the faid Land.

III. AN.D be it Enacted, by the Authority aforefaid, That William Johnston, James Hogg, John Sheels, William Courtney, and James Watfon, Esquires, be, and are hereby appointed Commissioners of the faid Town; and they, or a Majority of them, are hereby impowered to bring the former

AND be it Enacted, by the Authority aforefaid, That from and after To lay a Tax. the palling of this Act the Commissioners, or a Majority of them, shall, and they are hereby required, within Twenty Days after the First Tuefday in June in every Year, to lay fuch Taxes as they shall judge necessary, not exceeding Twelve Shillings and Six Pence per Poll, on all the taxable Perfons in the faid Town; which Tax shall be collected by Warrant under the Hands and Seals of the Commissioners, or a Majority of them, directed to any Perfon they shall appoint to collect the fame, returnable at fuch Time as shall be therein mentioned; which faid Collector appointed as aforefaid, is hereby impowered to collect and make Diffrefs for the fame, in like Manner as other Collectors of Public or County Taxes shall be impowered by Law; and the Moncy arising therefrom, after deducting Five per Cent. Commissions, shall by him be paid into the Hands of the Commiffioners, or a Majority of them, to be by them applied and laid out in clearing and repairing the Public Streets, Lanes, and Allies, and in any other Public Work they may judge necefiary for the Benefit of the faid Town.

V. AND be it further Enacted, by the Authority aforefaid, That the Lifs of Taxa-Inhabitants of the faid Town thall, and they are hereby required, to give given in. in a Lift of all the taxable Perfons in each of their respective Families, on Oath or Affirmation, to fome one of the Commissioners aforefaid, between the First and Second Tuefdays in June in every Year, under the Penalty of Three Pounds for every Neglect; to be recovered by Warrant under the Hands and Scals of the Commillioners of the faid Town, or the Majority of them, to be applied to the Public Stock of the faid. Town.

VI. AND be it Enacted, by the Authority aforefaid, That all Perfons reliding Three Months in the faid Town next before the First Tuesday in June in every Year, shall afterwards be subject to pay Taxes in the faid Town.

(Ci3) VII. AND be it further Enacted, by the Authority aforefaid, That no Perfon shall after the passing of this Act be obliged to work on the Streets or other Public Places in the faid Town, or to pay any other Town Tax but fuch as is herein before mentioned.

VIII. AND be it further Enacled, by the Authority aforefaid, That no Inhabitant of the faid Town shall, on any Pretence what sever, keep any Hog or Hogs, Shoat or Pig, or any Geefe, running at large within the Bounds of the faid Town, on Penalty of forfeiting fach Hog or Hogs, Shoat or Pig, or Geefe, and paying the Sum of Twenty Shillings (or Two and One Half Dollars) to the Party aggrieved ; and further, that it shall and may be lawful for any Person whatever after the Tenth Day of June next to fhoot, kill, or otherwife deftroy, fuch Hog or Hogs, Shoat or Pig, or Geefe, to running at large within the faid Town.

CHAP. I.

An Act to chablifb a Militia in this State.

THEREAS a well regulated Militia is abfolutely necessary for Preamole the defending and fecuring the Liberties of a free State :- .:.

II. BE it therefore Enacted, by the General Affembly of the State of North-Carolina, and it is bereby Enacted by the Authority of the fame, That the Militia of this State be divided into fix Brigades, wiz. One in each of the Districts of Edenton, Newbern, Wilmington, Helifax, Salifbury, and Hillfborough, and each Brigade to be commanded by a Brigadier General. And the Militia of every County shall confift of all the effective Men from fixteen to fifty Years of Age inclusive, to be formed into one or more Regiments, each under the Command of a Colonel, Lieutenant Colonel, and two Majors ; every Regiment shall be divided into Companies, confifting of fifty Rank and File at least, two Serjeants, two Corporal's, one Drummer, and one Fifer; and each Company to be under the Command of a Captain, Licutenant, and Enfign. That every Companies to Company shall be divided into four Divisions, who shall draw Lots for go on Servi the first, second, third, and fourth Turns to go on Service, and shall be numbered according to fuch Lots.
