

CHAPTER 80.

AN ACT TO INCORPORATE THE SALISBURY HOOK AND LADDER COMPANY, NUMBER ONE, OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY.

The General Assembly of North Carolina do enact :

SECTION 1. That Theo. F. Kluttz, W. R. Barker, Alex. ^{Body politic.} Parker, R. M. Davis, W. A. Welborn, W. S. Negus, R. L. Saon, W. L. Skahon, and such other persons as they may associate with them, and their successors, be and they are hereby constituted a body corporate under the name and style of the Salisbury Hook and Ladder Company, num- ^{Name.} ber one, of the city of Salisbury.

SEC. 2. That said body corporate shall have power to <sup>Corporate pow-
ers.</sup> sue and be sued, plead and be impleaded by their corporate name, to use a common seal, to purchase and hold real and personal property not to exceed six thousand dollars in value, and to adopt such by-laws and regulations, as may be necessary for the good government of the same.

SEC. 3. This act shall be in force from and after its ratification.

In the general assembly read three times, and ratified this the 11th day of March, A. D. 1881.

CHAPTER 81.

AN ACT TO ENABLE THE CITY OF WILMINGTON TO PROVIDE FOR THE BONDS MATURING IN THE YEAR ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-TWO.

The General Assembly of North Carolina do enact :
