

- -1881 GFD Co. No. 1 was organized and stationed on the 100 block of N John.
- -1913 Purchase of 1st motorized fire truck.
- -1919 1st 1000gpm pumper was purchased.
- -1920 Eight paid firemen were hired.
- -1929 George Mabry hired as paid Fire Chief.
- -1939 New Headquarters was built on Ash.
- -1953 1st Rescue vehicle placed in service.
- -1956 Station 2 was opened.
- -1957 1st aerial truck was purchased.
- -1966 Station 3 was opened.
- -1972 1st white fire truck was purchased.
- -1976 Headquarters was moved to the new
- Police-Fire Complex
- -1982 Station 4 was opened.
- -1998 Station 5 was opened.
- -2000 Station 2 relocated to Royall Ave.
- -2001 Fire truck color is switched to red.
- -Currently have 96 personnel
