

**WAKE COUNTY FIRE COMMISSION
APPARATUS COMMITTEE**

TO: All Fire Commission Members

The apparatus committee would like to present two (2) requests one (1) from Apex FD, and one (1) from Morrisville both Departments request that their Rescue Units be moved to FY 2013.

Apex: Their Rescue was originally due in FY 2012 but was moved to 2014 by request Chief Haraway due to funding. They are now requesting that it be moved back due to the fact that it will not pass Federal Inspection, and is beyond repair.

In talks with Chief Haraway Apex Fire Chief, Chief Woods Apparatus Chair, Jason Horton Wake County Budget Office, and Demetric Potts Wake County Fire Marshall's office, and further discussions with the Apparatus Committee Members, it was agreed to support this request for FY 2013.

Apex Fire Department will be replacing their Rescue and a Pumper with one (1) Vehicle, thus reducing their fleet by one (1), which in return is a cost savings to the Budget.

Morrisville: Their Rescue was originally scheduled for FY 2011, it was moved to 2014 per discussions between the Apparatus Committee and Chief Wright in September 2007. Discussions between the Apparatus committee and Chief Wright, which also included the Budget Office, and the Fire Marshall's Office the Budget can handle this also. The apparatus committee supports their request.
